Climate education fellowship program addresses environmental challenges, particularly climate change, by equipping individuals with the knowledge and skills needed to become effective advocates and leaders in their communities. Such fellowships provide comprehensive training in climate science, policy, and communication, fostering a deep understanding of the complexities of environmental issues.

Fellows learn how to engage diverse audiences, from policymakers to the general public, effectively conveying the urgency and importance of climate action. Through networking opportunities and collaborative projects, fellows can leverage their collective expertise to develop innovative solutions and initiatives that promote sustainability and resilience.

Through our latest project, sponsored by <u>Climate KIC</u>, we have successfully trained and incubated over 54 fellows, equipping them with essential climate knowledge and entrepreneurship skills to establish their own green businesses. Notably, 70 percent of this cohort comprises young women from Arusha and Dar es Salaam regions, where our hubs are located.
