

Menstrual Hygiene outreach, Sexual Reproductive Health education and seminar in 2022 and 2023 in KISARAWE and MONDULI Districts respectively | Partnered with the French Embassy in Tanzania.

In collaboration with the <u>French Embassy in Tanzania</u>, our project, implemented by our climate change organization, addressed critical issues of menstrual hygiene and sexual reproductive health in Kisarawe and Monduli Districts.

Recognizing the nexus between gender equity, health, and climate resilience, our objectives were clear, to increase awareness among women and girls, distribute over 2000 sanitary pads to over 1000 young girls and women, and provide comprehensive sexual reproductive health education to both men and women to promote healthier practice.

As a result of our efforts, significant outcomes were achieved, contributing to both public health and climate resilience. There was a noticeable improvement in menstrual hygiene practices among women and girls in the targeted districts, which also had positive implications for environmental sustainability.

Our initiative facilitated strengthened partnerships between institutions, organizations and local communities, creating opportunities for future collaborative endeavors that address the intersection of gender, health, and climate change.
